Permit for REMOVAL of Underground Storage Piping for Petroleum and Hazardous Substances.

Permission to remove underground storage tank piping is hereby granted. Such removal shall not commence until the contractor the permit was issued to or an employee of that contractor (this does not include a subcontractor) shall establish a date certain to perform the UST activity by contacting the Office of the State Fire Marshal, Division of Petroleum and Chemical Safety, at which time the UST activity shall be scheduled. **THIS PERMIT IS VALID FOR SIX MONTHS FROM THE APPROVAL DATE.**

The satellite line from dispenser number 6 appears to have a leak on the primary. No release is evident as this site had double wall piping and sumps.

We are going to remove the failed line and install new 1.5" APT piping in its place.

NOV on tank 4 is in the process of being completed.
