This is in accordance with the Illinois Administrative Code 176.360 (a) regulations and 40 CFR Part 280.72 (a) Federal Register Requirement.
- (5) <u>SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES</u>: Removal of all product piping, tank, transition and dispenser sumps only.
