THIS PERMIT IS VALID FOR SIX MONTHS FROM THE APPROVAL DATE.

- (5) **SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES**: Install two 20-pound high potential magnesium anodes through a mini test station on the premium tank. Install One additional 20-pound high potential magnesium on each of the unleaded and midgrade tanks since the remote readings do not meet the -850 millivolts criterion.
