This is in accordance with the Illinois Administrative Code 176.360 (a) regulations and 40 CFR Part 280.72 (a) Federal Register Requirement.
- (5) <u>SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES</u>: There is to be one (1) 1,000-gallon used oil underground storage tank removal. It will be removed from 2811 5th Ave in Rock Island. Seneca Companies will be cleaning, excavating under the UST, sampling, and acting as the licensed remover for this project.
