- (5) SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES: Please see attached scope of work. We are adding one new fuel island and installing new dispenser and Bravo UDC on the new island next to their already existing 2 fuel islands. The new fuel island will get a new island form. We will connect new Ameron/Dualoy LCX Fiberglass into the existing piping run of the existing UST's to connect piping to the new fuel island. We will be replacing the existing despensers on the existing fuel islands with new dispensers and new Bravo UDC's. The 2 exisiting island will not be replaced with new island forms, using their existing island forms and setting the new dispensers on these exising islands. That is why i picked reconstrucing islands so i could explain each island from. The existing 2 lane 2 column canopy will be taken and a new 3 column 2 lane canopy will be installed. We will re-use their existing TLS350. We are setting a new 4000 gallon DEF UST. Attached scope of work explains it more in detail. Thanks.
