Remove and discard the fill cap and adaptor, remove and save the drop tube. 3. Furnish and set one (1) Emco A1004EVR317S diesel spill bucket. 4. Re-install the drop tube, furnish and install a swivel fill adaptor and flat cap. 5. Water test the spill bucket. 6. Backfill, pin to the existing concrete and repour.
