The double walled rigid fiberglass E85 product line has failed a line test. The leak iis not in either the diespenr or pump sumps. It is in the buried portion of the line and would be externely difficult to find. The entire underground line will be replaced with flexible double walled pipe. The line only runs from the pump sump to one dispenser sump.
