A required job schedule for cathodic protection upgrade of underground storage tank(s) and piping must be submitted to the Office of the State Fire Marshal, Division of Petroleum and Chemical Safety. **THIS PERMIT IS VALID FOR SIX MONTHS FROM THE APPROVAL DATE.**

Each anode has a 12" manway where it was installed and plan is to install anodes through the manways. Site will be resurveyed after installation and structure continuities will be checked back to rectifier negative.
