Permission to enter underground storage tank(s) is hereby granted. Such tank entry shall not commence until the contractor the permit was issued to or an employee of that contractor (this does not include a subcontractor) shall establish a date certain to perform the UST activity by contacting the Office of the State Fire Marshal, Division of Petroleum and Chemical Safety, by telephone at the Springfield office between 8:30 a.m. and 12:00 p.m., at which time a mutually agreed upon date and time for the UST activity shall be scheduled. **THIS PERMIT IS VALID FOR SIX MONTHS FROM THE APPROVAL DATE.**

- (5) SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES:** Tank relining, lining inspection and entry permit work in reference to manways/manholes must abide by sections 170.430(a)(1)(C) and (D), 170.430(b)(5), and 170.430(c)(10). Multiple IEMA numbers: H20070428, H20070441, H20070482. Also, for some unknown reason, there is a tank #476 that comes up on the permitting computer screen. Tank #476 does not exist and it is a mystery as to why it is on the permitting computer screen but not on the registration screen - this is a mystery of computer cyberspace and we have no idea how it got there or how to get rid of it from cyberspace. All we know is that "tank #476" does not exist and it never did exist in the real world according to our records (it only exists in the cyberworld). Permit #00515-2007REM for these tanks is valid until 10/16/07.
