**Permit for REMOVAL of Underground Storage Tank(s) and Piping for Petroleum and Hazardous Substances**

Permission to remove underground storage tank(s) or piping is hereby granted. Such removal must be in complete accordance with all sections and procedures specified in 41 Illinois Administrative Code Parts 174, 175 and 176 . The contractor the permit was issued to shall establish a date certain to perform the UST activity by scheduling the permitted activity through their UST contractor portal account. If the Storage Tank Safety Specialist (STSS) observes evidence of a release, the owner, operator or designated representative of the UST owner/operator must notify the Illinois Emergency Management Agency (IEMA). The incident number shall be given to the STSS prior to his/her leaving the site. After the removal is completed, the owner/operator shall have a site assessment performed by measuring for the presence of a release where contamination is most likely to be present at the UST site. This is in accordance with the Illinois Administrative Code 176.360 (a) regulations and 40 CFR Part 280.72 (a) Federal Register Requirement.

**Summary of Work**

EnviroServe will remove the liquid contents and check the UST atmosphere. The UST will be uncovered exposing the top of the tank. The overburden will be stockpiled adjacent to the excavation for eventual reuse as backfill. Once the OSFM arrives, we will test the UST atmosphere again. If atmosphere is acceptable, EnviroServe will remove the UST from the ground with mechanical equipment. The UST will be placed on plastic sheeting and blocked to prevent rolling. The LEL will be measured prior to cutting the tank open. A three-foot by three-foot hole will be cut in the side of the tank. The interior of the tank will be cleaned to the satisfaction of the OSFM. All rinse water will be collected in 55-gallon drums for future disposal. Soil confirmation samples will be collected from the walls and floor of the excavation and the piping trench, if applicable. A sample will be collected from the overburden stockpiled adjacent to the excavation.

**Special Contingencies**

The owner must notify this Office when completion of tank removal has occurred, on the Notification for Underground Storage Tank Form. This form can be obtained at www.sfm.illinois.gov or by calling (217)785-1020. After removal is completed, the owner/operator shall perform a site assessment by measuring for the presence of a release where contamination is most likely to be present at the UST site. This is in accordance with the Illinois Administrative Code 176.360 (a) regulations and 40 CFR Part 280.72 (a) Federal Register Requirement.
