Summary of Work

New tank sump lids will be installed on all three tank sumps. The existing flex connectors and steel piping in the tank sumps will be replaced. Any existing entry boots that are in disrepair will be replaced. New dispensers and single wall dispenser containment sumps will be installed. The existing flex connectors and emergency valves will be replaced. Any existing CP protection in any of the dispenser sumps and tank sumps will be removed. The existing double wall FRP piping will be cut back to install the dispenser sumps and reinstalled into the new dispenser sumps.
