<u>Permit for REMOVAL of Underground Storage Tank(s) and Piping for Petroleum and</u> Hazardous Substances

Permission to remove underground storage tank(s) or piping is hereby granted. Such removal must be in complete accordance with all sections and procedures specified in 41 Illinois Administrative Code Parts 174, 175 and 176. The contractor the permit was issued to shall establish a date certain to perform the UST activity by scheduling the permitted activity through their UST contractor portal account. If the Storage Tank Safety Specialist (STSS) observes evidence of a release, the owner, operator or designated representative of the UST owner/operator must notify the Illinois Emergency Management Agency (IEMA). The incident number shall be given to the STSS prior to his/her leaving the site. After the removal is completed, the owner/operator shall have a site assessment performed by measuring for the presence of a release where contamination is most likely to be present at the UST site. This is in accordance with the Illinois Administrative Code 176.360 (a) regulations and 40 CFR Part 280.72 (a) Federal Register Requirement.

Summary of Work

Expose USTs. Pump out any remaining tank product. Inert or Vent Tanks. Test Tanks with LEL monitor. When LEL is <5% or O2 is <5%,two openings will be cut into each tank. Tanks will be cleaned and any scrapings will be placed into 55 gal drums or pumped sludge/product tank. Non-sparking tools will be used. Tanks will be removed with a backhoe. Tanks will be made unusable and placed on a trailer for tranpsort to a scrap yard. Soil samples will be collected from walls and floors for laboratory analysis.

Special Contingencies

NOTE: Removal of tanks and all associated piping

The owner must notify this Office when completion of tank removal has occurred, on the Notification for Underground Storage Tank Form. This form can be obtained at www.sfm.illinois.gov or by calling (217)785-1020. After removal is completed, the owner/operator shall perform a site assessment by measuring for the presence of a release where contamination is most likely to be present at the UST site. This is in accordance with the Illinois Administrative Code 176.360 (a) regulations and 40 CFR Part 280.72 (a) Federal Register Requirement.
