The contractor the permit was issued to or an employee of that contractor (this does not include a subcontractor) shall submit a required job schedule for flex connector of underground storage tank(s) to the Office of the State Fire Marshal, Division of Petroleum and Chemical Safety. **THIS PERMIT IS VALID FOR SIX MONTHS FROM THE APPROVAL DATE.**

(3) UPGRADE OR REPAIR OF FLEX CONNECTORS:

- (b) *Type of flex connector(s):* (TK # 1, 2, 3) - Existing steel flex connectors, (TK # 1, 2, 3) Existing Existing double wall fiberglass
