- (5) <u>SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES</u>: Contractor is removing the concrete around the overfill container on the diesel tank, and will dig down to the top of the tank at the fill pipe to check for any leaks in that area. The fill pipe opening will be sealed and the tank tested for leaks. The fill pipe and overfill container will be re-installed on the tank and the system tested again for leaks.
