- (5) <u>SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES</u>: This permit was originally approved by Dan Starks. All emergency repairs require a permit applied for after the fact on the next business day and require a final inspection scheduled pursuant to section 175.320(d)(4) 10 days after issuance of the permit (see section 175.710(a)). The final inspection must be scheduled by 12/01/14. (The computer did not originally link this emergency repair request to the permit application when it was approved; therefore, linking this permit to the emergency repair request had to be done manually on 12/16/14).
