- (5) <u>special contingencies</u>: Contractor is replacing the ball float valve riser only. Contractor states he can isolate the riser from the tank and therefore will be able to air test the riser / vent line, and not have to air test the tank. Vent lines must be tested at 7 psi minimum or at a pressure recommended by the manufacturer. All steel risers, vents, and fills in contact with the ground, backfill or water shall be dielectrically wrapped or coated.
