A required job schedule for cathodic protection upgrade of underground storage tank(s) and piping must be submitted to the Office of the State Fire Marshal, Division of Petroleum and Chemical Safety. **THIS PERMIT IS VALID FOR SIX MONTHS FROM THE APPROVAL DATE.**

(5) **SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES** : Installing sacrificial anodes at submersible pump containment sumps for cathodic protection to flex connectors and steel piping due to water ingress. This is the result of a NOV.
