DIESEL TANKS - INSTALL NEW OPW BG 101-2100 SPILL FILL, OPW 61SO SHUT OFF VALVE, REMOVE EXISITING STP POLY SUMPS AND REPLACE WITH FRP SUMPS, REMOVE DISPENSER SUMPS AND REPLACE WITH BRAVO FRP DISPENSER SUMPS. MOVE VENTS FROM TOP OF TANK TO INSIDE THE NEW FRP SUMP.

WASTE OIL -NEW OPW BG101-2100 SPILL BUCKET WITH 61T DROP TUBE, INSTALL A WATER TIGHT LID ON THE EXISTING TANK SUMP,
