- (5) SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES: Install a new tank sump on tank1, new dispenser sumps for Diesel and K1 dispensers as the shear valves are so low we have to cut the sump away to get to them. Raise all shear valves to the correct height. For all of the sumps we will match whatever piping is there now. The site shows it has both double wall and single wall pipe. Install new drop tubes on tanks 5 and 7. Islands for diesel and K1 will be replaced in the same locations as they are now. NOTE: Dispensers must have sumps installed after piping underneath is broken if no sump is existing, per 175.410 d)
