Caseys will be adding onto the existing canopy and we will be adding one island to the two that are already there, all islands will be new with new APT dispenser sumps. Tank are to remain with all new tank fittings installed. if there are enough openings on the existing tank we will put in duel point vapor recovery if not it will stay single point. All sumps will have sensor in them, veeter root is existing to stay.
