
(5) **SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES** : Removing the existing ball float vent valves, Removing the existing anodes in the tank sumps , Installing new EBW 705 Defender series 5 gallon s/w spill buckets with OPW 61SOP-4012 coaxale overfill drop tube in tank # 1 & OPW 71SO-410C in tank # 2. Installing new FE Petro submersibles with Veeder Root PLLD, new steel flex connector & brass ball shut off valves, Installing new Franklin Fueling tank sump lids to make the sumps water tight.
