The contractor the permit was issued to or an employee of that contractor (this does not include a subcontractor) shall submit a required job schedule for underground piping upgrade, leak detection, spill and overfill prevention of underground storage tank(s) to the Office of the State Fire Marshal, Division of Petroleum and Chemical Safety.

(4) The owner must notify this Office when completion of tank upgrade/repair has occurred, on the Notification for Underground Storage Tank Form and the licensed contractor must submit the required job schedule for underground piping upgrade, leak detection, spill and overfill prevention to the OSFM prior to the work being performed. Both forms can be obtained at www.sfm.illinois.gov or by calling (217)785-1020.

(5) SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES :

Permitting to **replace the failed ball float** vent valves for ID #1-2 with OPW 61SOP overfill drop tube valve assemblies due to failed testing of the vent valves. Replacing the ball float vent valve on ID #4 with OPW 71SO 4000 overfill drop tube valve assembly due to failed testing of the vent valve. Also replacing the ball float vent valve on ID #3 with OPW 61SOP overfill drop tube valve assembly to make facility uniform.

Upon ordering equipment for the permitted activity we were informed that the 61SOP drop tube valve for ID #4 (diesel) has been

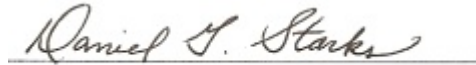
discontinued. The part number will be 71SO 4000. The 61SOP valves for ID #1-2-3 are still manufactured and will be installed.
