Removing the ball floats and installing new EBW 708 defender series over fill valves on both tanks. If the bakk floats cannot be removed the ball floats will be knocked out and the over fill valves set to 90% as instructed. Had to replace both riser pipes due to corrosion. Customer to have tank tested.

Upon removing the overfill valves the techs had to remove and install new riser pipes for both tanks. Customer has a tank test scheduled.
