**Permit for REMOVAL of Underground Storage Piping for Petroleum and Hazardous Substances.**

Permission to remove underground storage tank piping is hereby granted. Such removal shall not commence until the contractor the permit was issued to or an employee of that contractor (this does not include a subcontractor) shall establish a date certain to perform the UST activity by contacting the Office of the State Fire Marshal, Division of Petroleum and Chemical Safety, at which time the UST activity shall be scheduled. **THIS PERMIT IS VALID FOR SIX MONTHS FROM THE APPROVAL DATE.**

This is in accordance with the Illinois Administrative Code 176.360 (a) regulations and 40 CFR Part 280.72 (a) Federal Register Requirement.

(5) **SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES :**

Removing gas lines only on this permit, Install permit to follow site will extend canopy adding mor islands etc. Diesel lines will be on other permit by other contractor CPEC . Vents will be removed from biulding and installed in new canopy addition we will show this on installation permit etc.

**NOTES: This permit replaces previous permit 01565-2019REM which was taken out by a different contractor. Also, the piping work will need to be done under an UPGRADE permit, not an Install permit.**
