**(5) SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES :**

Water table is very high and the probe risers and tank manway lids are always under water and are screwed into tank access man-way. I will add a bag anode on the riser and to the metal manway lid and test.

**NOTE: From N.O.V. - Tank access manway sumps are full of water exposing the tank access manway lids to corrosion. Corrosion protection must be installed to protect the metal tank access manway lids**

Amendment Reason: Also adding cathodic protection to the RUL tank access manway

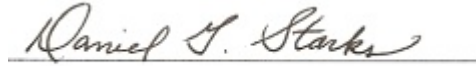
