Such removal shall not commence until the contractor the permit was issued to or an employee of that contractor (this does not include a subcontractor) shall establish a date certain to perform the UST activity by contacting the Office of the State Fire Marshal, Division of Petroleum and Chemical Safety, by telephone at the Springfield office between 8:30 a.m. and 12:00 p.m., at which time a mutually agreed upon date and time for the UST activity shall be scheduled. **THIS PERMIT IS VALID FOR SIX MONTHS FROM THE APPROVAL DATE**.

- (4) The owner must notify this Office when completion of tank removal has occurred, on the Notification for Underground Storage Tank Form This form can be obtained at www.state.il.us/osfm or by calling (217)785-1020. After removal is completed, the owner/operator shall perform a site assessment by measuring for the presence of a release where contamination is most likely to be present at the UST site. This is in accordance with the Illinois Administrative Code 170.640 (a) regulations and 40 CFR Part 280.72 (a) Federal Register Requirement.
- (5) SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES: Amendment request received 03/12/2008 to include tanks 4 and 5; (this latest amendment will only be allowed due to the fact that tanks 4 and 5 were removed while inspector Siegler was on site for the removal of tanks 1,2,3. The permit was essentially field amended to reflect this fact no other amendments to this permit will be allowed. A new permit will have to be sent for tanks 6 and 7). Revised 02/19/08 to reflect the correct ownership information from an amended notification form received 02/11/2008 (any further changes will require a \$200.00 amendment fee). Contractor must send in an amended notification form to officially change the ownership name of this site. Our records show Villa @ Liberty LLC as the ownership name. Amendment request to correct the ownership name and to include two more pre-74 tanks (tanks 2 and 3) on this permit was received 02/06/08.
