A required job schedule for cathodic protection upgrade of underground storage tank(s) and piping must be submitted to the Office of the State Fire Marshal, Division of Petroleum and Chemical Safety. **THIS PERMIT IS VALID FOR SIX MONTHS FROM THE APPROVAL DATE.**

Amendment Reason: Steel pipeline was uncovered during anode installation. An additional sacrificial anode was installed to protect the pipe.

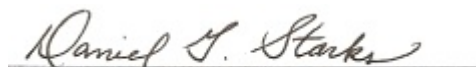
