After removal is completed, the owner/operator shall perform a site assessment by measuring for the presence of a release where contamination is most likely to be present at the UST site. This is in accordance with the Illinois Administrative Code 176.360 (a) regulations and 40 CFR Part 280.72 (a) Federal Register Requirement.
- (5) <u>SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES</u>: This system has not been in operatin since 2015 we will be removing the 2 10k frp tank and all the piping from the ground and backfilling with a compactable material.
