(5) <u>SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES</u>:

Remove multiport spill bucket systems and excavate to tank top. Install new fill and vapor risers; install OPW grade level spill buckets and new OPW overfill prevention drop tubes.

NOTE: Our records indicate the existence of ball floats, therefore the contractor needs to either remove or disabled them at the time of drop tube installation. If disabling, then the drop tubes must be set at 90% shut off.
