Permit for REMOVAL of Underground Storage Piping for Petroleum and Hazardous Substances.

Permission to remove underground storage tank piping is hereby granted. Such removal shall not commence until the contractor the permit was issued to or an employee of that contractor (this does not include a subcontractor) shall establish a date certain to perform the UST activity by contacting the Office of the State Fire Marshal, Division of Petroleum and Chemical Safety, at which time the UST activity shall be scheduled. **THIS PERMIT IS VALID FOR SIX MONTHS FROM THE APPROVAL DATE.**

The existing product lines, tank sumps, and islands will be removed to make way for new pipe, sumps and islands.

The product lines trench will be tested according to current regulations by Forest Consulting.

The excavation contractor will have 40 hours OSHA training as well as the businesses cutting the concrete. The Electrician is also 40 hour certified.

Central Petroleum Equipment Company will have a registered removal technician onsite for the duration of the removal.
