(5) <u>SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES</u>:

The underground tank has (1) existing 1 inch fuel supply line to the building generator. The existing fuel line will be replaced by the new. The new pipe will be (10 1 inch Omegaflex brand pipe from the UST to the building. The route for the new pipe is not in the same trench as the old pipe. When the new pipe is installed the old pipe will be disconnected form the tank and drained and then abandonned in place under a separate permit. The change over from the old pipe to the new pipe will happen within a few hours so as not to take the generator system off line for more than 2 hours. There is no change to the tank top containment. The tank top containment is only a cyliner to keep gravel away and not a containment sump.

There is NO change to the vent pipe, fill or other fuel system components. There is NO fuel return line.

Replaced piping exceeds 20 feet or 50% of the total pipe run.

NOTE: A removal permit must be obtained for the old piping that is being replaced
