Permit for ENTRY into Underground Storage Tank(s) for Petroleum and Hazardous Substances.

Permission to enter underground storage tank(s) is hereby granted. Such tank entry shall not commence until the contractor the permit was issued to or an employee of that contractor (this does not include a subcontractor) shall establish a date certain to perform the UST activity by contacting the Office of the State Fire Marshal, Division of Petroleum and Chemical Safety, by telephone at the Springfield office between 8:30 a.m. and 12:00 p.m., at which time a mutually agreed upon date and time for the UST activity shall be scheduled. **THIS PERMIT IS VALID FOR SIX MONTHS FROM THE APPROVAL DATE.**

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(3) ENTRY OF TANKS:

- (a) **Number and size of tanks being entered:** (TK # 2) - 10,000 gallons
- (b) **Type of tanks:**

(4) The owner must notify this Office when completion of tank entry has occurred, on the Notification for Underground Storage Tank Form. This form can be obtained at www.state.il.us/osfm or by calling (217)785-1020.

(5) SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES: Tank relining, lining inspection and entry permit work in reference to manways/manholes must abide by sections 170.430(a)(1)(C) and (D), 170.430(b)(5), and 170.430(c)(10). Tank #2 began taking on water. Visual inspection shows water leaking into tank through seam in fiberglass tank. Containment Solutions has been hired to enter the tank and inspect it prior to making repairs.
