The work will entail the excavation and removal of a 9,000 gallon USTs formerly containing acetone and previously legally abandoned in place as well as a 10,000 gallon UST previously containing ethanol and previously legally abandoned. Both tanks are located at 1219 Glen Rock Avenue Waukegan, IL. Once approval is received from the OSFM the tank will be removed, cut and cleaned in accordance with applicable regulations.
