After removal is completed, the owner/operator shall perform a site assessment by measuring for the presence of a release where contamination is most likely to be present at the UST site. This is in accordance with the Illinois Administrative Code 176.360 (a) regulations and 40 CFR Part 280.72 (a) Federal Register Requirement.
- (5) <u>SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES</u>: This is the first phase of a site upgrade. Three 10,000 gallon tanks (2 Gas & 1 Diesel) and the associated product & vent lines will be removed
