(5) SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES :

Replaced piping exceeds 20 feet or 50% of the total pipe run.

Amendment Reason: The fuel island location has been changed. The fuel island will be 18 feet from the south property line, 10 feet from the east property line and >100 feet from the North & West Property line. The dispenser island will be >25 feet from the building. Moving the dispensing island from previous plan. Vents will stay on east side of building as originally planned. Island will be moved west of tanks approximately 70 feet.

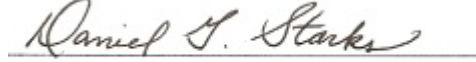
NOTE: Dispenser must maintain a full 10' from property lines and buildings
