- 1) Install new dual-wall APT pipe from tank 4 to the transition sump (in chase pipe).
- 2) Inside the transition sump, connect tank 4's new product line into the existing product line.
- 3) Wire pump controllers where pumps at tank 1 and tank 4 both come on when diesel dispensers are activated.

Tank 4 will become B11.

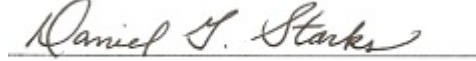
Replaced piping exceeds 20 feet or 50% of the total pipe run.
