This is in accordance with the Illinois Administrative Code 176.360 (a) regulations and 40 CFR Part 280.72 (a) Federal Register Requirement.
- (5) <u>SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES</u>: Remove the existing FRP tanks(12k and 8k), islands, product and vent lines. A new fueling system will be installed at this location
