Permit for REMOVAL of Underground Storage Piping for Petroleum and Hazardous Substances.

Permission to remove underground storage tank piping is hereby granted. Such removal shall not commence until the contractor the permit was issued to or an employee of that contractor (this does not include a subcontractor) shall establish a date certain to perform the UST activity by contacting the Office of the State Fire Marshal, Division of Petroleum and Chemical Safety, at which time the UST activity shall be scheduled. **THIS PERMIT IS VALID FOR SIX MONTHS FROM THE APPROVAL DATE.**

- (5) <u>SPECIAL CONTINGENCIES</u>: Pulling out old product lines from the chase pipes associated to the tank sumps of Tank 1 and Tank 2 to the existing UDCs. Also removing product line from the secondary tank sump and UDC to the low flow dispenser connected to Tank 1. Removing low flow dispenser and installing cover plate for that UDC. Removing STP from secondary Tank 1 sump and plug entry.
