Remove existing Wayne Harmony Column mount dispensers. Remove entire 8' x 40' island concrete (5) lanes total. Reuse South dispenser sumps and install dispenser anchor boxes and pipe up from existing piping.

On the North side of the canopy we will retro fit product piping from existing dispenser sump and run new Ameron double wall LCX piping to new Bravo sump north of canopy column.

We will add new sump sensors to new sumps only. Existing sumps have sensors already

Pour new island area and crown concrete at each dispenser (10) total

Install new Wayne Ovation dispensers
