

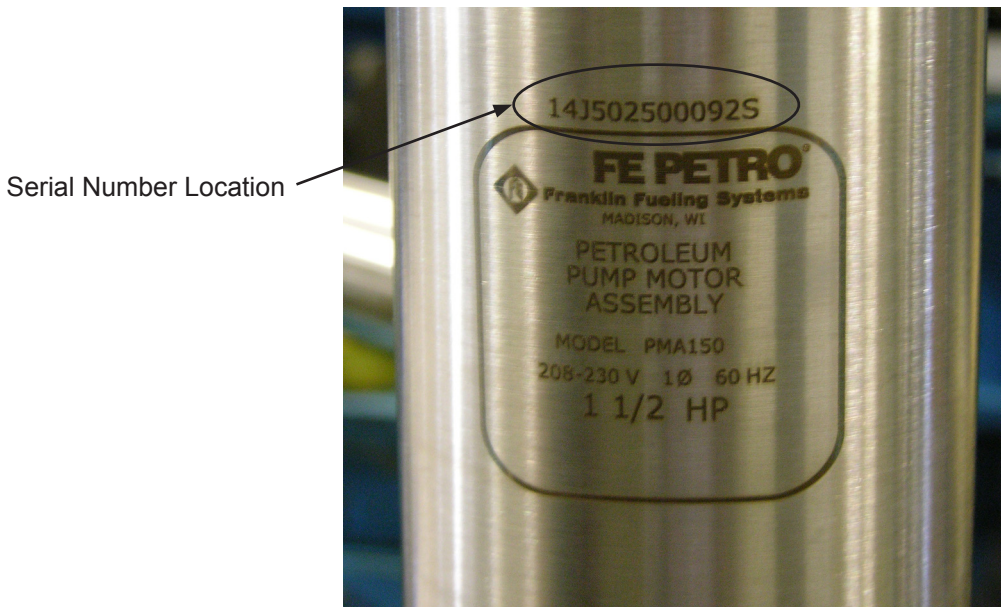

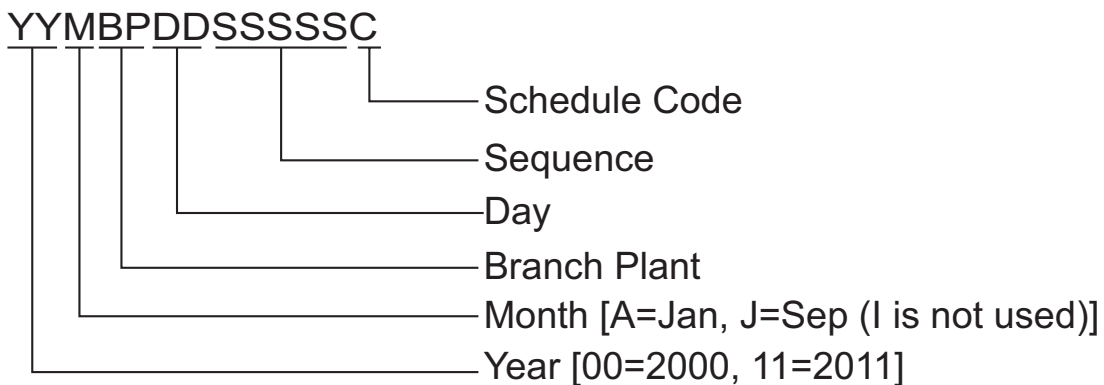

Location of Serial Number



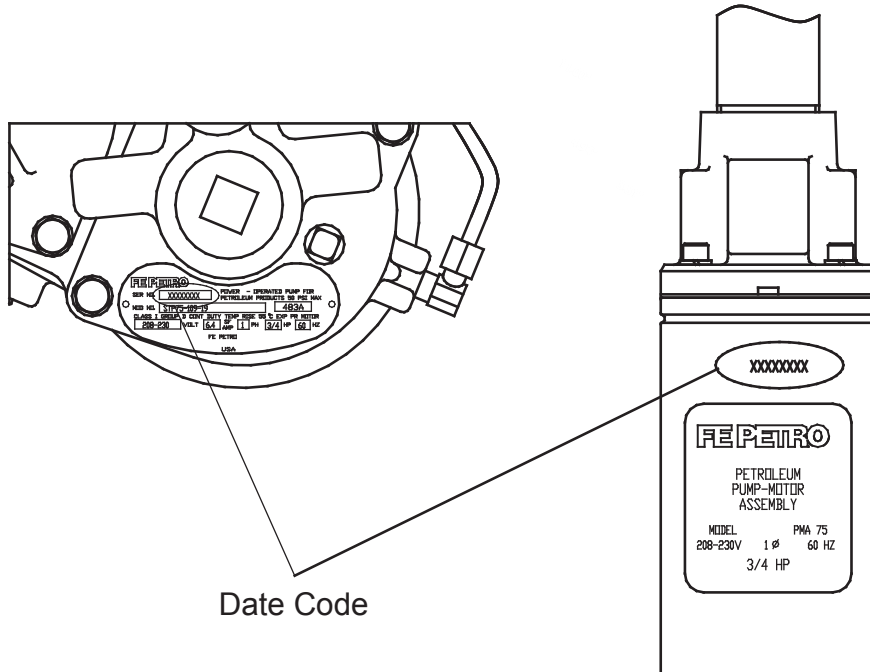

Serial Number	Explanation of Serial Number
14J502500092S	2014, September, Branch 50, 25 th day, 92 nd Unit, Schedule Code S
15K570301332S	2015, October, Branch 57, 3 rd day, 1332 nd Unit, Schedule Code S



Date Code

Serial Number From July 1998 to May 2014

The serial number for all STPs, PMAs, STP-MLDs and other products is a date coded sequence. The first two digits indicate the year of manufacture, the second two digits indicate the month of manufacture, and the last four digits indicate the series unit number.

Examples

Identified on Product	Explanation of Serial Number
98071004	July, 1998 – 1004 th unit built
99010001	Jan., 1999 – 1 st unit built
00110293	Nov., 2000 – 293 rd unit built
01050598	May, 2001 – 598 th unit built
